By providing education, prevention, early identification and intervention, elementary school counselors help their students achieve academic success, develop an understanding of career opportunities and develop social/ emotional skills in response to issues they face.

THE COUNSELOR MAY SEE STUDENTS FOR:

<u>Classroom Guidance</u>

I have the opportunity to see every student through classroom guidance. In classroom guidance, we will explore topics related to social/emotional, academic, and career development: character education, friendship, bullying, emotions, goal-setting, college & careers and more.

Small Group Counseling

In small groups, students meet with the counselor along with other students to develop similar skills. Students may engage in activities to help with school success skills, social skills, coping skills, decision-making skills, self-esteem, friendship skills and leadership skills.

Individual Counseling

The counselor meets with students individually. Students may talk with a school counselor about a variety of things - feelings, relationships, understanding others, and problem-solving are just a few. No concern is too big or too small.
